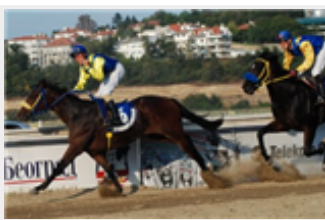

MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE CHAIRMAN

As we look forward to the Middle Park, Cheveley Park and Sun Chariot Stakes on the Rowley Mile, and a strong British challenge to Sea the Stars in the Prix de L'Arc de Triomphe, later in the week – we can reflect with satisfaction upon Group 1 British-bred successes for Mastery in the St.Leger at Doncaster, Regal Parade in the Haydock Sprint, Hibaayeb in the Meon Valley Stud Fillies Mile at Ascot, and Aqlaam in the Prix du Moulin at Longchamp.

Next Tuesday sees the start of Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sales. All lots entered, catalogued, and sold or bought in at the Sale, will be eligible for the eight races comprising the 'Tattersalls Millions'. Prize money amounting to a massive £1.75m – total cost to run in the eight race series will be only £4,000.

An added incentive to buyers in Books 1, 2, and 3 of the Tattersalls Yearling Sales will be the 2009 Racing Post Yearling Bonus Scheme, which was successfully launched at the DBS St.Leger Sale. With this brilliant new initiative, owners could win an extra £10,000 if their yearling is registered to the scheme and goes on to win a two year old bonus race next year.
