GOVERNING BODY

The governing body of the National Trainers Federation (NTF) consists of a Council of eighteen members with a three member Presidential Triumvirate. Six geographic regions each supply a Chairman and two deputies to the Council. The main function of the Council and its committees is to represent and protect the interests of all members of the Federation in all matters which affect the business of training racehorses, and in all negotiations with other bodies in the racing industry.
